

How to Stream CYMBELINE: A FOLK TALE WITH MUSIC

COMPUTER STREAMING

- 1. Click the link in the email confirmation.
- 2. Enter your password in the new window that opens within your browser when prompted.
- 3. The stream should start playing automatically.

Looking to connect to your TV?

If your computer and TV both have HDMI inputs, you can connect them via an HDMI cable and stream right on your TV.

SMARTPHONE OR TABLET STREAMING

- 1. Click the link in the email.
- 2. Enter password in the new window that opens within your browser when prompted.
- 3. The stream should start playing automatically.
- 4. You may want to use headphones for optimal audio while viewing.

CHROMECAST STREAMING

- 1. Click the link in the access email on your computer or smartphone.
- 2. Enter password in the new window that opens within your browser when prompted.
- 3. Once you've accessed the video, you can watch via Chromecast by selecting the three vertical dots in the upper right-hand corner of your browser window.
- 4. Select "Cast" and then select the compatible Chromecast device. You should now be set to watch.

SMART TV STREAMING

You have two options for accessing the video on Vimeo through your Amazon FireStick, AppleTV, Roku, or SmartTV:

1. If your SmartTV has a web browser, simply go to your email on the web, open your access email and follow the COMPUTER STREAMING steps above.

- 2. Use the Vimeo App on your Smart TV.
 - a. Create or log in to a Vimeo account in a browser on your computer, phone, or tablet. Accounts are free, and you only need a name, email address, and password to create one.
 - b. Once you're logged in, click the link provided in the access email and enter the password in the new window that opens within your browser when prompted.
 - c. When the video appears, tap the clock icon in the upper right corner under the heart icon. This will add the video to your account's "watch later" list.
 - d. Once you've added the video to your "watch later" list, login into your Vimeo account on your Amazon FireStick, AppleTV, Roku, or SmartTV.
 - e. Select "Library," and you should see your "Watch Later" list where the video should now be. Click on the video to begin watching.
